Abraham,2012-12-06 Prostaglandins Leukotrienes and Cancer is a multi volume series which focuses on an emerging area of cancer research In 1968 R H Williams first reported that elevated prostaglandin levels are present in human medullary carcinoma Since that time the concept that arachidonic acid metabolites may be involved in cancer has expanded to include every aspect of the disease from cell transformation through metastasis Prostaglandins and leukotrienes are generic terms used to describe a family of bioactive lipids produced from unsaturated fatty acids principally from arachidonic acid via the cyclooxygenase and lipoxygenase pathways respectively Cyclooxygenase products consist of diverse products such as prostaglandin E2 PGE2 prostacyclin PGI2 and thromboxane A2 TXA2 whereas lipoxygenase products consist of hydroperoxy fatty acids and mono di and tri hydroxy acids including leukotrienes lipoxins and epoxides The precursor fatty acids for the cyclooxygenase and lipoxygenase pathways are present in cellular phospholipids This finding established an important control point in their biosynthesis the release of substrate This occurs in response to numerous stimuli that act at the cell surface Dr Bengt Samuelsson s extensive study of the metabolism of prostaglandins indicate that they are rapidly inactivated on a single pass through pulmonary circulation Thus they cannot act as circulating hormones and appear to be made on demand in the vicinity of target tissues leading to the concept that prostaglandins are local hormones or autoids Altered production qualitative and or quantitative of prostaglandins and leukotrienes has been implicated in the development of a number of disease states e g Cell Separation Science and Technology Dhinakar S. hidden structures resembling some important neu humoral mediators e g noradrenaline serotonin dopamine in the molecules of ergot alkaloids could explain their interactions with these receptors 1 Ergot alkaloids are produced by the filamentous fungi of the genus *Claviceps* e g *Claviceps purpurea* Ergot Mutterkorn On the industrial scale these alkaloids were produced mostly by parasitic cultivation field production of the ergot till the end of the 1970s Today this uneconomic method has been replaced by submerged fermentation Even after a century of research on ergot alkaloids the search still continues for new more potent and more selective ergot alkaloid derivatives
