Beginning Philosophy:

How to Misunderstand Kierkegaard Stuart Dalton, 2022-09-27 This book is an attempt to write about Kierkegaard's philosophy in the style of Kierkegaard's philosophy: energetic, playful, free-spirited, surprising, and joyous. It is a deliberately crumbly book in the sense that it seeks out the fragments, scraps, and crumbs of philosophical arguments that are generally ignored or swept away like so much rubbish but that are actually the most interesting parts of the meal. The Anti-Assistant Professor Method that this book follows adopts Kierkegaard's many excellent jokes about assistant professors as a guide to how not to write about Kierkegaard's philosophy: specifically, don't cease to be human, don't be a parasite merely feeding off other people's creations, and never creating anything new. Don't reduce or simplify or systematize Kierkegaard's ideas in order to make life easier for everyone because that was never the point. Don't kill Kierkegaard's philosophy by lecturing on it, thereby turning it into a collection of dead ideas for nonhumans rather than subjective truths that need to be lived. Following these guidelines, the book attempts to extend and amplify some of Kierkegaard's most important ideas in a way that combats the persistent problem of nihilism, a disease that even Kierkegaard succumbed to at the end of his life.

Hegel, Husserl and the Phenomenology of Historical Worlds Tanja Staehler, 2016-12-07 GWF Hegel famously described philosophy as its own time apprehended in thoughts reflecting a desire that we increasingly experience, namely the desire to understand our complex and fast-changing world. But how can we philosophically describe the world we live in? When Hegel attempted his systematic account of the historical world, he needed to conceive of history as rational progress to allow for such description. After the events of the twentieth century, we are rightfully doubtful about such progress. However, in the twentieth century, another German philosopher, Edmund Husserl, attempted a similar project when he realized that a philosophical account of our human experience requires attending to the historical world we live in. According to Husserl, the Western world is a world in crisis. In this book, Tanja Staehler explores how Husserl thus radicalises Hegel's philosophy by providing an account of historical movement as open. Husserl's phenomenology allows thinking of historical worlds in the plural without hierarchy determined by ethics and aesthetics. Staehler argues that through his radicalization of Hegel's philosophy, Husserl provides us with a historical phenomenology and a coherent concept of a culture that points to the future for phenomenology as a philosophy that provides the methodological grounding for a variety of qualitative approaches in the humanities and social sciences.
