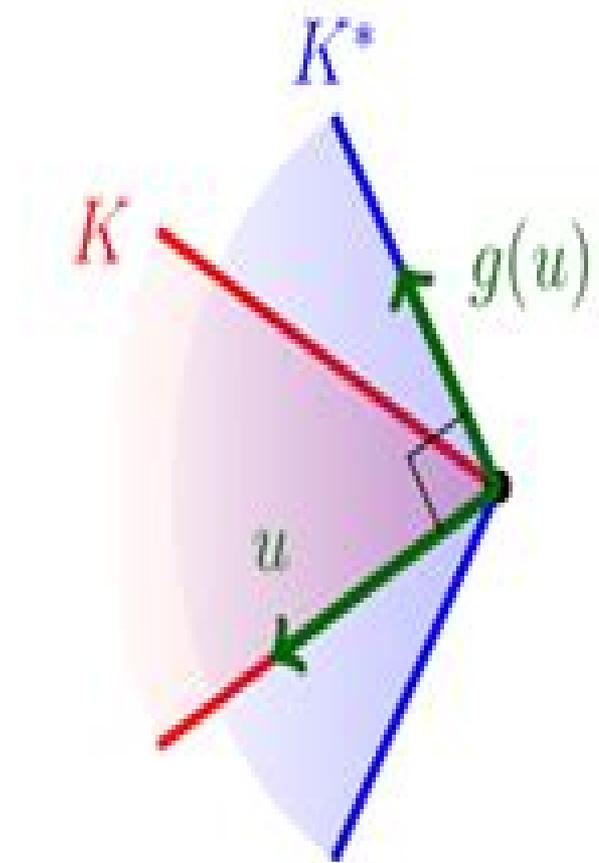


(a) A variational inequality.
