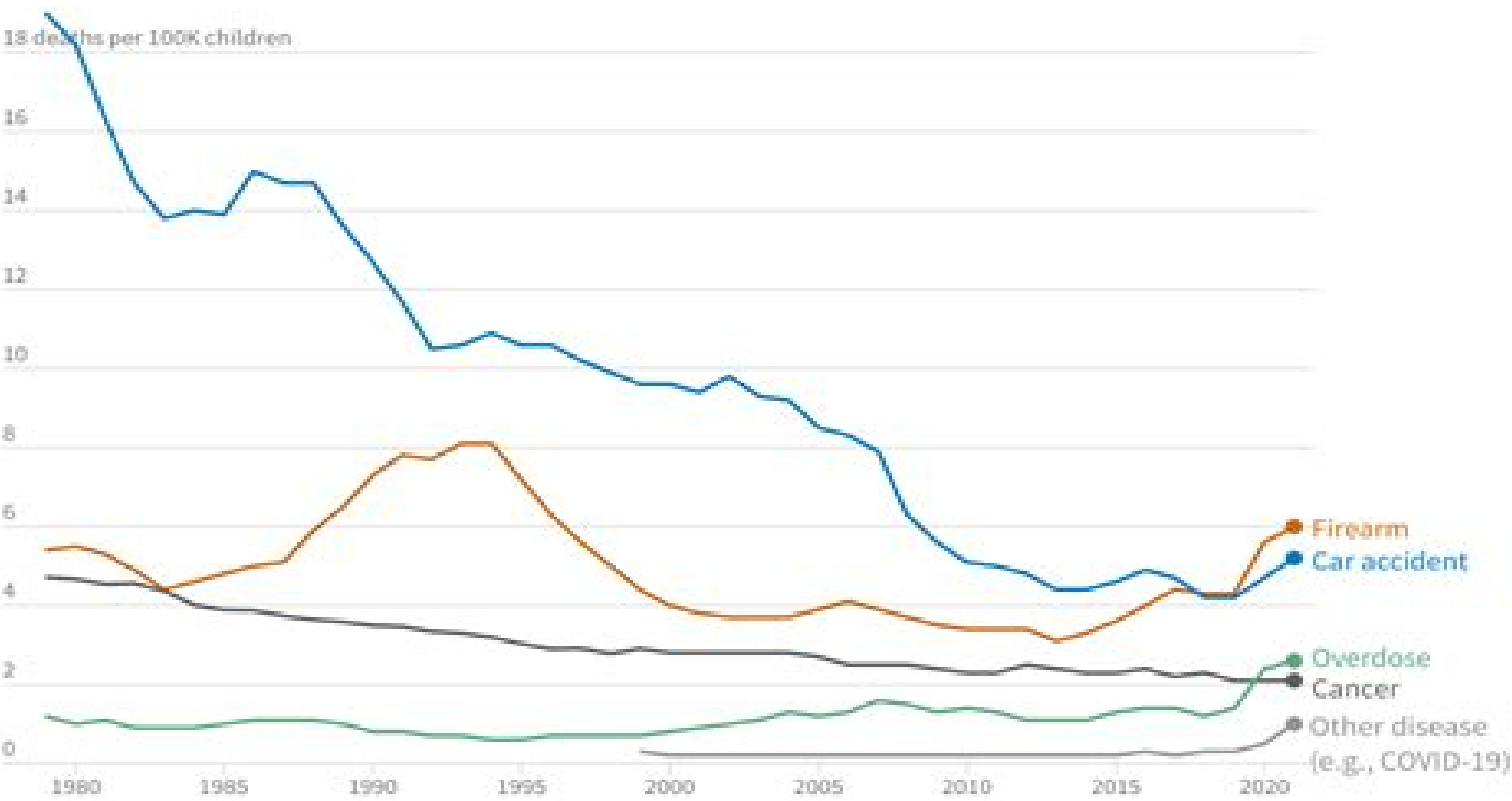


In 2020, firearm injuries became the leading cause of death in children
